WHAT IS GLASS?

The Girls Leadership Academy for Service & Sport (CLASS) is an international leadership development program designed for high school female athletes. Led by a team of former college athletes, GLASS empowers, transforms, and inspires female leaders.

Hosted in Costa Rica, each 10-day session includes sports-performance training, service-learning, leadership development workshops, mentorship from former college athletes, and adventure!

STUDENTS RETURN HOME WITH:

- An enlivened sense of independence and confidence
- An enhanced understanding of the leadership skills and values learned through sport
- Greater awareness of other communities and cultures
- A dynamic network formed with like-minded peers and mentors
- A stimulated sense of adventure

Enrollment is open to student-athletes from all sports, all levels. The program is designed to help student-athletes recognize and cultivate the leadership skills learned through sports.

2023 PROGRAM ITINERARY

- Day 1 San Jose Arrival day! Students arrive to San Jose International Airport. Our staff will be at the airport awaiting students' arrivals.
- Day 2 San Jose Our first full day will start with typical Costa Rican breakfast—gallo pinto, fresh fruit, and eggs—then meet for Welcome & Orientation. In the afternoon, we'll complete our first group workout and wrap-up the day with a leadership workshop.
- Day 3 San Jose We'll workout in the morning and then host our first sports clinic for local youth. Later, we'll depart for a guided city tour of San Jose. We'll round out the day with a leadership workshop and salsa lessons!
- **La Fortuna** We leave early in the morning for La Fortuna—location of the famous Arenal Volcano! Upon arrival, we'll host our second sports clinic for local youth. In the afternoon, our staff will lead our daily workout and leadership workshop. In the evening, we'll visit Baldi Hot Springs for dinner and relaxation!
- Day 5 La Fortuna In the morning, we'll zip-line and hike through the rainforest! We'll conclude the day with downtime and leadership.
- Playa Potrero Morning road trip to Playa Potrero—a local Costa Rican beach town. Once we arrive, we'll acclimate ourselves to our final home base with a town tour and beach visit! We'll soak up the last hour of sun with a sunset beach workout and round out the day with leadership.
- Playa Potrero In the morning, we'll volunteer at Barbara's Cat & Dog Shelter. In the afternoon, we'll host our third sports clinic. During our leadership for the day, our Mentors will facilitate a service-learning reflection to capture key learnings from the service component of the program.
- Playa Potrero We'll start with morning surf lessons! Our Mentors will host our leadership workshop in the early afternoon.. We'll conclude with souvenir shopping, dinner, and sunset viewing in a nearby town called Playa Brasilito.
- Playa Potrero We'll begin with our last leadership workshop and workout. In the afternoon, we'll set sail on a catamaran tour. Our program will conclude with a GLASS Wrap-Up, hosted by our staff.
- Day 10 Departure Day Students will be accompanied by staff to Liberia International Airport for departure.

Note: Itinerary will change slightly based on the needs of our service partners. A final itinerary will be shared in the pre-departure guide.
